

C6 Front Tow Hook Instructions

- 1. Remove front bumper, see Factory Service Manual
- 2. Test fit tow hook.
 - a. Tow hook should dip down
 - b. Place plate with holes against bottom of frame
 - c. Push tow hook forward until back stop is firmly against frame
 - d. Now slide tow hook to the side until the back stop touches the side rail
 - e. Tow hook can be installed on either the passenger or driver side
 - f. Driver side installation is easier because of less obstructions




Figure 1: Looking from engine bay showing tow hook location from under the car showing tow hook location

 - g. See fig 1, fig 2 and fig 4
- 3. When tow hook is in place, mark holes for drilling.
- 4. Center punch and drill hole locations with 33/64" drill bit.
- 5. Install rivet nuts with included instructions and installation tool.
- 6. Test fit tow hook to ensure proper rivet nut locations.
- 7. Remove tow hook.




Figure 3: Grill trim guide. Note small trim areas at top. installation

- 8. Mark and cut grill, See fig 3. Figure shows both Driver and Passenger cut locations.
- 9. Replace the front bumper, see Factory Service Manual.
 - a. do not install lower panels under the bumper
- 10. Make final installation of the tow hook through the grill.
- 11. Reinstall remaining lower panels, see Factory Service Manual.
